Description of the graduate work

Academic program

The program aims to provide the student with knowledge of the concept, specifications, importance and application of various banking operations and their development related to banking systems. The student is also provided with information about the functions of various banks and studying the application of banking systems and the use of their applications in the public private sector.

Required program outputs

Mode and Duration of Study

The Diploma Program in the Department of Banking and Financial Technologies spans over two academic years. and the student is required to complete summer training, which is one of the requirements for obtaining the certificate.

Graduation Requirements

Students are required to successfully complete (61 hours) for the two years in addition to summer training (270 hours), for the total academic hours to be 1950 hours.

Medium and Course Assessment

The program is taught in Arabic and English.

On the campus, theoretical and practical lectures will be given, as well as providing scientific resources and books in the field of document handling and implementing bank accounting restrictions to help the student understand the mechanisms of banks 'work and how to deal with them.

Each subject is evaluated with daily activities, writing practical reports, daily, quarterly and final exams
